Supplemental Application for Employment Part-Time Firefighter/Paramedic

This application is in addition to our general member application.

The Montgomery and Countryside Fire Protection District has created the position of part-time Firefighter/Paramedic. This position is for applicants that are interested in working for the Montgomery and Countryside Fire Protection District, are currently certified as a Firefighter and EMT-Paramedic, meet the qualifications as noted below in this application, and currently live beyond our response area for a paid-on-call firefighter. This position requires the member to actively participate in department training, public and social events, work shifts, and respond back to major incidents when available.

In order to be considered for part-time employment with the Montgomery and Countryside Fire Protection District, the following minimum requirements must be met. The requirements include, but are not limited to:

1. Be at least 19 years of age.
2. Be in good physical condition and mental health and able to perform strenuous manual labor.
3. Be in good moral character and not had any serious criminal activity history as determined by a background investigation conducted by the Montgomery and Countryside Fire Protection District.
4. Be able to work a minimum of 60 hours per month.
5. Respond back to major Fire and EMS incidents when available.
6. Document a minimum of 20 hours of fire training a month in the ESO firehouse software records management system.
7. Participate in Wednesday evening training sessions from 7 p.m. until 10 p.m., when available.
8. Actively participate in the Montgomery and Countryside Fire Protection District Firefighters Association to include all public, social and fundraising events.
9. Possess a valid non-CDL class B Driver's License (or equivalent) issued by the state in which the applicant resides.
10. Be a High School graduate or equivalent.
11. Be a U.S. citizen or possess work authorization from the U.S. Department of Immigration and Naturalization.
12. Possess certification from the Office of the State Fire Marshal:
 - Fire Fighter 2 or Basic Operations Firefighter
 - Hazardous Materials First Responder or Operations
 - Technical Rescue Awareness
 - Fire Service Vehicle Operator or Provisional
 - Fire Apparatus Engineer (preferred)

13. Possess a current, valid license from the Illinois Department of Public Health as an EMT Paramedic in Southern Fox Valley EMS System.
14. Possess a current, valid CPR card.
15. Upon employment offer, obtain and maintain for duration of employment approval to function within the Southern Fox Valley EMS System.

Part-Time members of the Montgomery and Countryside Fire Protection District work the following shifts;

- Weekday*, 10 Hour Shifts, Monday Through Friday shifts, from 7 a.m. until 5 p.m.
- Weekday*, 14 Hour Shifts, Monday through Friday 5 p.m. until 7 a.m.
- Weekday*, 24 Hour Shifts, Monday through Friday 7 a.m. until 7 a.m.
- Weekend*, 12 Hour Shifts, 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. or 7 p.m. until 7 a.m.
- Weekend*, 24 Hour Shifts, 7 a.m. until 7 a.m.

*Holdovers are arranged for members leaving early for another job, or coming off shift from another job
